RE: LRRCN - State of Local Emergency, Office Closures, Essential Services, Travel Advisory & Checkpoint Highway 58 (50 meters west of John D'or Prairie access)

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, Sunday, March 22nd, 2020. Little Red River Cree Nation has entered into a State of Local Emergency (SOLE), and Additional Extreme Measures are now in place

1. All Nation Buildings are CLOSED to the public, and only authorized personnel are allowed to enter these buildings.
2. Chief and Council have declared a State of Local Emergency (SOLE), which activates additional Extreme Measures Provisions.
3. Only Essential Travel and Services will be allowed to go through the checkpoint. Please see below for the description and explanation.

What is Essential Travel and Services?

- Returning LRRCN membership and LRRCN non-membership residents
- Those who are travelling for medical purposes.
- Those who are responding to medical emergencies and public health purposes – which includes government and emergency responders.
- LRRCN members are free to go through the checkpoint in any direction.
- Fuel, Food, and medical services.
- Authorized Personnel

NON-NATION MEMBERS WHO DO NOT RESIDE IN ANY OF THE COMMUNITIES WILL BE TURNED AWAY AT THE CHECKPOINT UNLESS PROPER DOCUMENTATION OR CLEARANCE IS GIVEN!

Little Red River Cree Nation will also have a twenty-four (24) hour checkpoint in place. This checkpoint is located on Highway 58 (50 meters west of John D'or Prairie access). Residences leaving and returning from any of the three communities will be give a coloured day-pass at the check point.

If you are a resident of one of the three communities, you will be require to fill out a coloured day-pass. If you must leave and venture out our Nation for goods and services, we strongly recommend that you take extreme caution, practice extreme social distancing, and we advise to self-isolate for a minimum of fourteen (14) days upon your return. (Fox Lake, John D'Or Prairie, and Garden River)

These additional Extreme Measures are put in place to limit the risks of spreading and/or having a COVID-19 outbreak within our Nation.
