DO HEREBY RESOLVE: DECLARATION OF A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS** the undersigned, being the duly elected Council for the Little Red River Cree Nation (the "Nation") by way of an election of Chief and Councillors (collectively known as "Council"), each of whom have one vote and are empowered to vote on and act upon each Band Council Resolution ("BCR") passed by simple majority, on behalf of the Nation, and;

**WHEREAS** Council having met in quorum at a duly convened meeting, and

**WHEREAS** an emergency exists in Little Red River Cree Nation due to COVID-19 Pandemic- Disaster Emergency Management Plan for Little Red River Cree Nation

**WHEREAS** the Chief and Council who has appointed Dwayne Laboucan as the **Director of Emergency Management** and Roberta Alook who is the **Deputy Director of Emergency Management** for the First Nation of Little Red River Cree Nation

**WHEREAS** the Chief and Council appoint the **Emergency Management Committee**, which includes all the **Program Directors/Managers and a Portfolio Councillor**. Committee Members will assist in the development of the Emergency Operation Plan and participate in training and exercises. Committee members will also ensure their staff members are aware of the plan and understand their roles and responsibilities, which enhances safety of the community and its members in the event of a major emergency or disaster

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** Little Red River Cree Nation declares a Mandatory Checkpoint Lock Down in conjunction with the State of Local Emergency that was passed on March 22, 2020. The Mandatory Checkpoint Lock Down goes into effect as of March 28, 2020, at 8:00 pm. Essential and Critical Services will be allowed to pass the checkpoint.
