- Create an individual care plan for Nation members who need help with health care.
- Visit our clients in their homes or at the Health Center - whatever works best for the client.
- Monitor client health including blood pressure, blood sugars, medications, hemoglobin, etc.
- Provide foot care to people who cannot cut their own toenails because of decreased mobility, thickened brittle toenails, curved nails, ingrown nails, fungus infected nails, diabetes, and those with corns or calluses.
- Provide help with bathing, getting dressed, brushing teeth, brushing hair, and catheter care, where needed.
