

PATHWAYS IN CAREER LEARNING FOR LRRBE STUDENTS

School courses and LRRCN's traditional values and positive ways of living prepare students for family, life, careers and post-secondary programs in our communities and elsewhere.

2 to 4 years

University Doctorate Degree and Professional Specializations

Any career can be studied to this level. Examples include land conservationist, indigenous knowledge specialist, doctor, nurse, pharmacist, dentist, teacher, administrator, engineer, social and community worker, veterinarian, accountant, etc.

Advanced University Degree - Master's

E.g. social worker, engineer, teacher, nurse. Includes M.A., M.Sc., M.S.E., M.S.W., M.Ed. etc.

I to 2 years

University Degree Bachelor's

E.g. Social Worker, Engineer, Teacher, Registered Nurse. Includes Bachelor of Arts - B.A., Bachelor of Science-B.Sc., Bachelor of Science in Engineering – B.S.E. Bachelor of Social Work-B.S.W., Bachelor of Education- B.Ed., BA in Native Studies and Bachelor of Commerce, etc. College Certificates and Diplomas

E.g. Licenced Practical Nurse (LPN), Social Work, Business, Early Childhood Education, Health Care, Legal Assistant, Arts & Sciences, Engineering, EMT, Forestry, Personal Fitness, Safety, Medical Technician, Water and Waste Water Technician, Veterinary Assistant, etc. Apprenticeship Technical Training*

E.g. cook, carpenter, mechanic, electrician, hairstylist, baker, painter/decorator, plumber, welder etc. Other Technical Training such as Heavy Equipment Operator.
Also includes Pre Apprenticeship Trades Prep including upgrading to meet minimum requirements for each trade.

Junior High and High School (Grades 7-12)

4 months to 2 years

If Required Upgrading and College Preparation

E.g. Adult Basic Upgrading, University and College Entrance Preparation.

Elementary School (Grades K-6)

Our schools follow Alberta Education curriculum and graduation requirements. All courses, certificates and diplomas from our schools are fully recognized anywhere in Canada. Our teachers are Alberta Education Certified and we offer accredited LRR Cree language and culture courses.
