Re: New Restrictions in Alberta regarding COVID-19 Working from Home if Possible

To all staff,

Regarding the recommendation to work from home in Alberta, if possible, made by Premier Jason Kenney on Tuesday November 24th, 2020. This was a recommendation.

Our EMT has discussed and we are confident the measures that are in place in all our Nation offices will be effective at this time.

These measures include:

- Frequent hand hygiene
- Disinfecting high touch surfaces often
- Wearing masks correctly (covering nose and mouth snuggly), unless in an office by yourself
- Plexiglass barriers
- Social distancing of 2 meters
- Appointments only for clients to control the number of people in the office
- Do not come to work if sick. Instead get tested for COVID-19 and stay home until well enough to come back to work.
- No social gatherings at work

At this time, all Nation employees will still be required to come to work. This may change in the future if we get another case of COVID-19 in our communities.
