Re: Continue with current Alberta Health Measures

To Nation Residents and Members,

Alberta Health has extended all current measures regarding COVID-19 due to the high rates of hospitalization and ICU admissions.

Most importantly:

- No indoor visiting
 - Unless someone lives alone, they can have up to 2 visitors but must always be the same 2 visitors.
 - People can still have babysitters, caregivers, home repairs, and health care in their home
 - Single parents who only live with their children under 18 can have 2 visitors, but must always be the same 2 visitors
- Outdoor gatherings can have up to 10 people, but nobody can go inside, and everyone must still social distance, wear a mask and not share items
- Mandatory work from home, unless a physical presence is required to do the work.
- Masks mandatory in all public places
- 20 people maximum at funerals.
