Re: Checkpoint Closed to Non-Residents of LRRCN

To Nation Residents and Members,

Due to the rising COVID-19 case numbers in Mackenzie County, we will be **closing our main** checkpoint to Non-Residents of LRRCN effective immediately.

- If you don't currently live in LRRCN, please do not come to checkpoint and ask to be let through. You will be turned around.
- It is too risky to allow visitors into our communities, where transmission in homes and vehicles is the main driver of infection.

Residents will still be able to leave the communities as needed to get their supplies as well as leave for essential services. You do not need a pass.

Contractors hired by LRRCN departments can still come into the communities, as they do not have direct contact with our residents.

- o Contractors must wear masks and sanitize their hands when entering job sites.
- They must not go into the stores or any other building that is not their job site.
- o They must not come to the job site if they are sick or awaiting results of a COVID-19 test.
- o They must stay at least 2 meters away from all LRRCN residents while on the job.
- o Contractors must not ride in a vehicle with any LRRCN residents.
- The LRRCN departments who have hired contractors to work in our communities must remind their contractors of these requirements.
- If you currently work in an LRRCN office, please contact your manager to figure out your course of action. Working from home should be an option. Daily commutes will not be allowed.
