Re: No Inter-Community Travel

To Residents and Members of LRRCN,

The Emergency Management Team is still asking that there is **No Inter-Community Travel** between John D'Or, Garden River and Fox Lake. We understand that some of our members are getting tired of COVID-19 measures to prevent the spread. There are more variants and an outbreak in one of the local communities and we have to be strong and continue not visiting. The more people who follow Alberta Health Guidelines now, the sooner we can come out of this situation.

This includes no visitors from out of town to John D'Or, Garden River, and Fox Lake.

Residents of LRRCN will still be able to leave their communities and travel through checkpoint for hunting, traditional gathering and healing, medicals, school supply shopping, and post-secondary activities.

We still have Active Cases in John D'Or, and we are going to get more. There is also a possibility of cases occurring yet in Fox Lake because of the funeral. It is not safe to travel from community to community. Most of the people who have tested positive for COVID-19 have No Symptoms, but they are still able to spread the infection. That means if they feel fine, they might think they are able to visit and are fine. But it still isn't safe. And eventually someone will get very sick. It is still too risky right now to let our guards down.

Please remember this is not forever. We are only helping each other by following these rules. If we start to see cases increased cases then stricter measures will need to be implemented in these communities too.
