June 21, 2023

Chief Conroy Sewepagaham took a two-day break from fighting fires and providing video updates. He travelled to Edmonton to sit down with Premier Danielle Smith and to attend their swearing-in ceremony at the Alberta Legislature Chambers. We want to Thank Minister Dan Williams for the invite! Here is the list of items we tabled for all of us to start working on:

1. Fox Lake Ferry (MOU signed on June 20th, 2023) with Minister Devin Dreeshen.
2. Expediting the paving of Highway 58 East.
3. Development of a Fox Lake Hospital.
4. Development of a Healing Lodge. (Mental Wellness Treatment Centre).
5. Development of an Addiction Treatment Centre.
6. Development and extend our Wildland Firefighting training for domestic and international deployment for our Little Red River Wildland Firefighters.
7. Development of an economic trade and commerce partnership to create more jobs for LRRCN and our neighbours around us.

In addition to this, we will be hiring a Utilities Consumer Advocate to help our Fox Lake Residents and Evacuees who are still being charged for electricity. Once this call centre is set up, we will post numbers on who to call.
