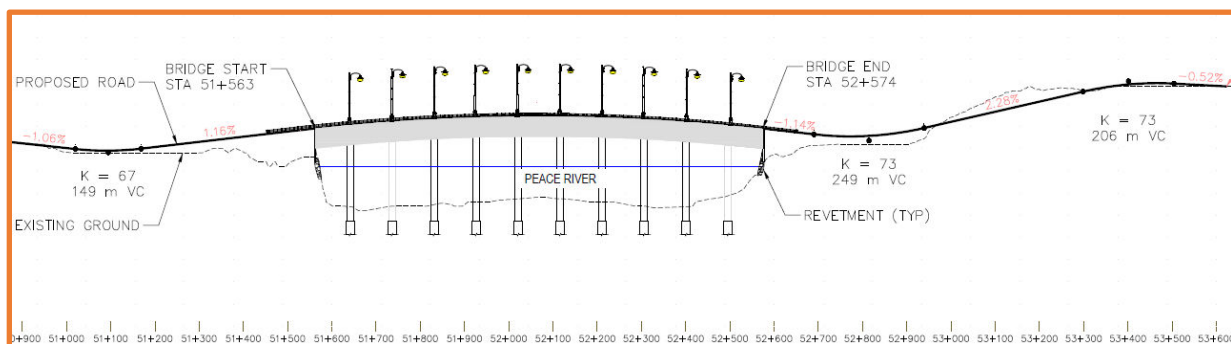


Fox Lake Bridge, Crossing over the Peace River

The community of Fox Lake access is limited and heavily impacted by ferry service interruptions, seasonal changes, and climate-related events. The performance of ice bridges has also been affected by fluctuations in river elevations. Improvement options have been explored and determined to be ineffective.

Little Red River Cree Nation has identified that an all-season bridge crossing over the Peace River at Fox Lake is required. The bridge will provide year-round reliable access to improve community emergent evacuation needs and support long-term Community development. The bridge would include two travel lanes and 1.0-metre shoulders on both sides. The bridge crossing location and profile are shown below:
